Breve perfil profesional.

The Centre for Industrial Technological Development (CDTI) is the Spanish Innovation Agency, attached to the Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness, which fosters the technological development and innovation of Spanish companies. CDTI employs over 300 people, three quarters of whom are engineers and graduates. Even though the bulk of the CDTI infrastructure is in Madrid, the Centre offers Spanish companies a strategic network of offices or representatives abroad, including China since 2002. Since 2009, CDTI has been the entity for the Ministry for Science and Innovation that channels the funding and support applications for national and international R&D&I project of Spanish.

Carlos Quintana is a Telecommunications Engineer by the Polytechnic University of Madrid. During his whole career he has worked at international level, first as Project Engineer working Space Engineer at High Technology European projects for the Space Sector; after that as member of the Spanish delegation at the European Space Agency; and then as CDTI Delegate at India first, and nowadays in China.

CHINEKA is the Sino Spanish Bilateral Program to foster the technology cooperation between entities of Spain and China through joint research and technology development projects.
